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1. What if I don't have grades for my last semester in high school? What will you use to determine admission?

Jefferson College allows for enrollment and placement based on 7th semester high school transcript and GPA. A student must provide a final high school transcript to enroll in subsequent semesters or to receive financial aid/A+ scholarship.

2. If my school is closed and I can't get my transcript, can I still be admitted and attend in the fall?

High school students can self-disclose high school completion allowing enrollment in the first semester. A student would need to complete his or her admissions file by sending his or her final high school transcript prior to subsequent enrollment. However, a student must provide a final A+ high school transcript prior to receiving A+ funds, including for the first semester. In addition, the U.S. Department of Education periodically selects a student's FA FSA for proof of high school completion. Course placement would be based on test scores or 7th semester GPA if we

Yes. Jefferson College will continue to honor dual credit coursework completed in the spring 2020 semester. All participating high schools in Jefferson County have moved their dual credit coursework to online and are completing the courses using the updated delivery mode.
