Required Documentation

As with all accommodation requests, students must provide appropriate documentation outlining the necessity of academic accommodations and their link to COVID-19. This documentation would need to be **signed** by a licensed medical professional who is not related to the student.

All documentation must provide the following information:

- Date of evaluation.
- Specific Diagnosis or Concern related to inability to wear a facemask.
